**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act protect bicyclists in bicycle lanes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 89 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 the following as Section 4D:

3 The operator of a motor vehicle shall not stand or park the vehicle upon any on-
4 street path or lane designated by official signs or markings for the use of bicycles, or place the
5 vehicle in such a manner as to interfere with the safety and passage of persons operating bicycles
6 thereon.

7 The operator of a motor vehicle shall not stand or park the vehicle upon any lane
8 designated by pavement markings for the shared use of motor vehicles and bicycles, or place the
9 vehicle in such a manner as to interfere with the safety and passage of persons operating bicycles
10 thereon.

11 SECTION 2: Section 5 of Chapter 89 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
12 replacing both references to “sections one to four C” with “sections one to four D.
